CampCo Day Camps is excited to have the opportunity to provide day camps for residents of San Clemente and surrounding areas! With all the new and exciting activities planned for this summer, it is certain that you and your Camper have some questions.

Daily Activities:

It's time for a crazy summer at the Beach!! Swimming, boogie boarding, sand castles, volleyball, Beach Olympics, walking field trips, crafts, songs and more! Campers will enjoy the beach each day, with swimming in the ocean on Monday, Wednesday & Friday afternoons and at the Ole Hanson pool on Tuesday & Thursday afternoons. Camp days are filled with traditional camp songs, crafts, games, afternoon swimming, water play and more, with many activities based on the daily themes.

Attached is a calendar of this summer's exciting themes for our Ole Hanson Beach Club School-age Day Camps. Activities will be held rain or shine, although adjustments to location or the nature of the planned activity may be changed. Activities are always subject to change. Please be advised that your child will be participating in activities such as painting and gluing. Daily Activities may include Crafts, Active Games, Quiet Games, Water Activities, afternoon Swim Time, Playground Time, Free Play, Snack/Lunch Time & other Activities. Daily Schedule to be determined at a later date.

Full-Day Camp Description (9am-4pm)

Each day has a different theme with crazy games, creative crafts and beach sports to match. Afternoons will be spent having lunch on the Beach, then playing in the ocean at North Beach (Mondays/Wednesdays/Fridays) or swimming in the Ole Hanson Pool (Tuesday/Thursday). Campers who are registered for City swim lessons at the Ole Hanson Pool during the camp day can be escorted to and from their lessons (permission slip required; service not available from 12-1pm).

Afternoon Camp Description (12-4pm)

The perfect option for campers who want to keep the momentum going from their morning specialty camp at other locations or for campers who want a lazy morning at home and jam-packed afternoons of crafts, games, songs, sports and more! Each afternoon, campers will play in the ocean at North Beach (Mondays/Wednesdays/Fridays) or swim in the Ole Hanson Pool (Tuesday/Thursday). Campers who are registered for City swim lessons at the Ole Hanson Pool during the camp day can be escorted to and from their lessons (permission slip required; service not available from 12-1pm).

What to Bring/Wear:

- ✓ Full Day Camp: Lunch, 2 Healthy Snacks and drink (non-perishable only; no refrigeration available) or Money for Snack Bar Lunch, 2 Filled Water bottles.
- ✓ Afternoon Camp: Lunch, 2 Healthy Snacks (non-perishable only; no refrigeration available), 1 Filled Water bottle.
- ✓ Mondays, Wednesdays & Fridays: Boogie Board or similar water toy (not required). CampCo will provide sand toys.
- ✓ Due to the high number of campers with severe "nut allergies", we are a "nut-free" camp. Please do not send campers with peanut butter sandwiches, candies or cookies with nuts, trail mix, etc...
- ✓ Children should wear weather-appropriate "play clothing" that can get paint, glue or other slimy stuff on it.
- ✓ Send your child wearing his/her swimsuit under their clothing, with a change of clothes for after swim time. To make it easier for female campers at restroom time, ideally they should wear 2-piece suits. Bring a Towel.
- ✓ Bring a Hat & Sunglasses.
- ✓ Please send children in closed-toed shoes; no flip flops or sandals.
- ✓ Apply sunscreen (SPF 30 or higher) to your child everyday & send a Bottle of Sunscreen with your Child.
- Children may not bring the following to camp: cell phones, personal radios/CD players, hand-held video games, toys from home, alcohol, drugs, animals, weapons of any kind. Other items may be restricted as staff feels necessary.
- ✓ Put your child's name on everything and place in a Backpack.
- ✓ Campers are encouraged to wear a CampCo Tie Dye T-shirt to camp each day!

Camp Location

Ole Hanson Beach Club, 105 West Avenida Pico, San Clemente, CA 92672 (near Pico and El Camino Real, (between the 7-11 store and the ocean). Call CampCo for directions, if necessary. Ole Hanson School-age Camps normally are based in Multi-purpose Room #1 (on the ground level of the facility), but occasionally are based in other classrooms. See sign-in location/information.

Drop-off and pick-up times are as follows:

Of course, you may drop off late or pick up early, but to keep the flow of our activities and to avoid camp disruptions, we ask that you drop off and pick up on time.

Drive-up Drop off and Pick up works as follows:

Parents who park in the parking lot and walk their campers to camp, must immediately stop at the Front Desk and get a daily parking pass to avoid receiving a ticket in the parking lot.

Parents are encouraged to participate in CampCo's convenient Drive-up Drop off and Pick up as follows:

- 1. Parents will be able to Drop off their children to CampCo Staff in the front of the Ole Hanson Beach Club at the end of Boca de la Playa.
- 2. CampCo requests that parents stay in their vehicle through sign in/out unless children need assistance fastening their seat belts. The Sr. Recreation Leader will bring the sign in/out sheet to each car. Please be prepared to show Photo I.D. at pick-up as we may have staff closing that day who may not know/recognize you.
- 3. Once your child is signed out, your child will be escorted to the vehicle.

Late-arrivals/ Early Pick-ups and Camps that start at 12pm

Parents who arrive after the morning Drive-up Drop off times, must walk their child to CampCo staff inside the Ole Hanson Multipurpose Room (on the lower level of the building). Parents who arrive between 12:05pm & 2:30pm on Monday/Wednesday/Friday or between 12:05pm-1pm on Tuesday/Thursday must walk their child to CampCo staff down to the beach.

Parents who want to pick up early must pick up no later than 30 minutes prior to the ending of the program (3:30). We request so that during the last 30 minutes of camp, campers have time to get their belongings together and walk to Drive-thru sign-out on time.

Sign-in & Sign-out

All campers must be signed in and out by a parent or authorized adult over 18 years old. Be prepared to show a photo I.D. in order to pick up your child each day. If anyone other than the parent or guardian will be picking up the child, a note from the parent or guardian must be presented when your child is dropped off for camp; the person picking up the child must present a photo I.D. at the time of pick up.

Late Pick-up Fees

Any parent who does not pick up their child by 10 minutes after the ending time of their child's camp will be charged a late fee of \$1 per child for every minute after 10 minutes late. The time will be determined by the Sr. Recreation Leader's watch.

Lunch/Snack Bar

Campers usually eat lunch shortly after 12pm. Campers may bring a lunch or purchase lunch from the Snack Bar at North Beach. The Snack Bar offers special CampCo meal deals for only \$5. Please send exact change for meals. Snack Bar meals tentatively include choice of one main food item (Hot Dog, Corn dog, Grilled Cheese, Tuna Sandwich, Hamburger or Chicken Nuggets), chips and drink (soda, juice or water.) Lunch orders are placed in the morning. Afternoon Campers must either bring their lunch or their parents must order snack bar lunch and deliver the lunch to the child's camp. Snack Bar may be closed without notice during inclement weather; in such cases, campers may be escorted to purchase lunch at 7-Eleven or another nearby location.

Campers must <u>bring</u> their healthy morning and afternoon snacks. On Wednesday afternoons, campers may purchase a snack from the 7-Eleven store near the Beach Club. Campers will walk to 7-Eleven with their counselors and must bring their own spending money. Campers <u>must bring</u> a healthy morning snack, but are permitted to purchase mid-afternoon snack from the Snack Bar. CampCo reserves the right to limit campers' consumption of certain items from the Snack Bar/7-Eleven (no nut items & limited candy/sugar treats).

Swim Time

Campers will be participating in water-related activities on a daily basis. On ocean swimming days (MWF), campers will not be permitted to play/swim past their mid-chest deep water. On swimming pool days (TuTh), campers will be tested for swimming ability once per week. Campers who "pass" the swim test will receive a blue wristband which shows that they have permission to swim in the deep end (9 ½ feet) during "deep end times". Campers who "do not pass" the swim test will receive an orange wristband which gives them permission to stay in the shallow end (3 ½ feet.) CampCo uses the "buddy-system" and does "buddy checks" during swim time to ensure safety. Supervision during swim time includes CampCo staff at a 1:10 ratio, each of whom is trained in American Red Cross Basic Water Rescue. Ole Hanson Beach Club provides trained lifeguards at this facility.

Walking Field Trips

Details regarding our Walking Field Trips will be listed on this letter soon.

Campers who are enrolled in other On-site Programs

If your child is enrolled at any other on-site Ole Hanson camp, swim lesson or other activity, our Camp Staff can provide complimentary pick-up of your child at their other program, during camp hours. Be sure to provide detailed information to the CampCo office; (949) 643-9008. CampCo is not responsible for campers while they are attending these other programs and will not stay with the campers while they attend these programs.

Emergencies

Should there be a local emergency (earthquake, fire, etc...), do not call the CampCo office or your child's camp site for at least 30 minutes after the emergency has occurred. It is vital that CampCo and camp site phone lines remain open so that we can make calls back and forth to our camp staff to check on campers, to call parents and to call emergency services, if necessary.

After an emergency, CampCo will only telephone parents of campers who are injured or in need of parent pickup. If everyone and everything is fine, parents will not be telephoned. Parents may want to check Facebook as CampCo may post a notice in our "status" regarding the emergency.

Contacting Staff or your Child at Camp

Parents who need to contact CampCo staff at the campsite, may telephone the CampCo office and messages can be relayed to Staff.

Please do not send a cell phone to camp with your child as they cause interruptions to the day's activities and are a distraction for campers. If a parent desperately needs to contact their child during the camp day, parents may telephone the CampCo office and important messages will be relayed by Office Staff.

Other Policies:

CampCo is not responsible for any items that may be damaged while at camp.

Children who are ill, become ill or sustain injury that may require medical attention during camp will not be permitted to remain at camp; parents will be contacted to pick up their child. Children are expected to behave appropriately and must follow rules when at camp. Parents will receive written notification of negative behaviors, injuries or illnesses.
