



## **KEEPING CAMPERS & STAFF SAFE DURING COVID-19**

### **March 1, 2021**

The safety of our campers, students, staff and their families is of the utmost importance. CampCo follows or exceeds all safety guidance for camps from the CDC and Federal, State and County governments. Safety measures subject to change as guidance changes. To minimize the risk of disease transmission during the COVID-19 pandemic, we are doing the following:

### **ALL PROGRAMS:**

- Social distancing of 6' between campers/students.
- No mixing of groups for large group games. No physical contact games.
- Handwashing schedule:
  - o Upon arrival.
  - o Every hour/between activities.
- Extra cleaning & sanitizing schedule, in addition to our normal schedule.
- Campers/students & staff wearing masks, covering both the mouth and nose, for most outdoor & all indoor activities, with the exception of when eating, drinking and swimming.
- Students who become ill are removed from the vicinity of others & parents must pick up promptly. Area sanitized.
- Staff are trained in disease transmission prevention including specific to COVID-19.
- Students & campers may not come to CampCo programs if they are sick, if they have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 or if a household member has COVID-19. Anyone who knowingly breaks this policy may be suspended from the program for the remainder of the year.

### **IN ADDITION, PLEASE NOTE THE SPECIFICS FOR THESE PROGRAMS:**

### **SUMMER CAMPS:**

- Drive-thru sign-in & out only. No contact sign-in/out; staff sign out for parents at their vehicles. Parents discouraged from walking in to sign in or out; please use our drive-thru times. Parents must wear masks when staff approach the vehicle.
- In the Drive-thru sign-in, CampCo staff test and record temperature of all campers & CampCo staff upon arrival. Anyone with a fever of 100.4 or higher may not attend camp.
- Verbal health questionnaire required, daily, at sign-in.
- Small groups of 10 campers each.
- Campers are grouped with siblings & other household members.
- Each group is supervised by one CampCo staff.
- Small groups are separated from other small groups.
- Most or all camp activities are held outdoors.
- Only use indoor spaces during rain/severe weather or for quick in & out. If using indoor facilities, all doors & windows are open, if possible, and multiple fans running.
- Any campers who become ill during the camp day will be immediately separated from the group and must be picked up promptly.
- Small group lists are kept on file for Covid-19 contact tracing, if necessary.

**LAS PALMAS PIPER CLUB AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM:**

- Small groups of maximum 16 students each.
- Children are grouped with siblings & other household members.
- Each group is supervised by one CampCo staff.
- Most or all activities outdoors. Indoor activities during inclement weather only. Parents encouraged to pick up early when we are required to be indoors.
- Drive-thru sign-out from 4:30pm-5pm.
- No contact sign-out; staff sign out for parents at their vehicles. Parents are not permitted to walk onto campus to sign out. Parents must wear masks when staff approach the vehicle.
- Small group lists are kept on file for Covid-19 contact tracing, if necessary.
