As we receive daily updates regarding the expected gradual opening of businesses in our community, our staff is busy preparing for a SAFE and fun Summer Camp 2020 at the Lake Forest Sun & Sail Club. To keep our campers and staff safe, CampCo will follow or exceed all safety requirements of the CDC and Local, County, State and Federal governments.

CampCo Summer Camp will likely look and run differently than our “normal” programs and will change throughout the summer depending on updated requirements.

Some of the changes we are considering:

- Small groups of ten campers only.
- Social distancing of 6’ between campers within each group.
- No large group or physical contact games.
- Most or all activities outdoors.
- Drive-thru drop off and pick up only. Parents discouraged from walking in to sign in/out.
- No contact sign-in & sign-out; staff sign in for parents at their vehicles.
- Extra cleaning & sanitizing schedule, in addition to our normal schedule.
- Staff wearing masks for some, all or only for indoor activities.
- Temperature testing of all staff and campers upon arrival to camp.

Of course, we will continue our normal disease transmission prevention policies and may add to them:

- All staff normally are trained in disease transmission prevention. We are adding training specific to COVID-19.
- Handwashing schedule, normally 4x – 5x a day. Possibly change to hourly.
- Campers may not come to camp sick, as usual.
- Campers who become ill at camp are removed from the vicinity of other campers and staff, and parents must pick up promptly, as usual. Area sanitized.
