CampCo North Beach Summer Camp Location:

Lake Mission Viejo, North Beach Entrance, 22555 Olympiad Road, Mission Viejo, CA.

Drive-thru drop-off/pick-up is available at specific times listed in **Drive-thru Drop-off & Pick-up** section, below.

Campsite:

North Beach Camp's home-base is Picnic Shelter #2 & its adjacent grassy area overlooking the Lake. Restrooms are conveniently available near our campsite. In addition to our campsite, we use the beach, sand volleyball court, playground, a CampCo-only swim area, & various grassy areas throughout the facility.

General Camp Info:

- Camp is open from 8am-6pm.
- Staff to Child ratio for North Beach Camp is 1:10.
- Children who are ill or injured may not attend camp. Children who become ill or sustain injury that may require medical attention during camp will not be permitted to remain at camp. Parents will be contacted to pick up their child & must do so within 30 minutes of our call/text.

Expected Behaviors at CampCo:

- Children are expected to behave appropriately & must follow rules when at camp.
- Parents will receive written notification of serious or repeated negative behaviors.
- Children who exhibit repeated or ongoing problematic behaviors at camp, or who harm another person or property, or who are a danger to themselves or to others or who are disrespectful to staff, other campers or others, may be suspended from our camps, short-term or permanently, at CampCo's discretion. No refunds or credits for the remainder of the current camp day/week that the child is suspended.

CampCo Lost & Found:

- Put your child's name on everything.
- CampCo is not responsible for items that may be lost, stolen or damaged while at camp.
- Lost & Found items are displayed, daily, for campers to look through. Occasionally, Lost & Found items are displayed during drive-thru. Parents may also want to check the Lake's Lost & Found bin located outside the Lifeguard Headquarters.
- Unclaimed items are donated mid-summer & on the last day of camp.

Preparing & Packing for Camp:

Print this Mini-Checklist. It's perfect for posting one on your refrigerator & another on the back of each child's bedroom door (so they can help pack, too): [ibd: LINK TO MINI-CHECKLIST](#)

What to Wear:

- Apply sunscreen (SPF 30 or higher).
- Wear swimsuit under their clothing. To make it easier for female campers at restroom time, ideally they should wear 2-piece suits. We do not take time to change into swimsuits before swim time.
- Wear weather-appropriate “play clothing” that can get messy.
- Campers are encouraged to wear their CampCo tie dye t-shirt, especially on Tie Dye Tuesdays & Thursdays. Shirts available for purchase in morning drive-thru line for \$15 each (cash or Venmo). Not required, but most campers wear them.
- Wear closed-toed, sturdy tennis shoes (sandals & Crocs are for swim time ONLY).
- Put child's name on EVERYTHING from head-to-toe.

What to Pack:

Each sibling child needs their own of each item....

- Put your child's **NAME ON EVERYTHING** & place in a Backpack (a separate backpack for each sibling).
- Bottle of Sunscreen (separate bottle for each sibling).
- Change of clothes in a PLASTIC grocery bag (for after swim time).
(Children will change, then put wet towel & suit in bag after water time. Write child's name on bag, too).
- Hat
- Sunglasses
- Beach Towel
- Swim Goggles
- Flip flops, sandals or Crocs (for swim time only)
- Two filled water bottles or a refillable bottle
- Lunch* or Lunch Money [REDACTED] Two Healthy Snacks. Optional money for afternoon Snack Bar [REDACTED]
*See **Lunch/Snacks & Snack Bar** section for details. **We are a “nut-free” camp.

Do NOT Pack/Send:

- Nuts or any items containing nuts of any kind. We are a nut-free camp.
- Cell phones, wristwatch communication devices.
- Electronics, iPads.
- Toys, dolls, stuffed animals, sports equipment, fishing gear...
- Animals of any kind.
- Weapons or toy weapons.
- Alcohol, drugs, vapes, tobacco items. Medications/epi-pens, must be given to Site Director upon arrival.
- Other items may be restricted as staff feels necessary.

Before Leaving Home:

- Give hugs & kisses at home before getting in the camp drive-thru line.
- Put your child's belongings in an easily-accessible location in your vehicle (in their lap, not in the trunk).
- Ideally, have child sit on the passenger side of the vehicle for the safest & easiest exit during drive-thru.
- Remind your camper about expected behaviors at camp.

Drive-thru Drop-off & Pick-Up:

Our convenient drive-thru makes drop-off & pick-up quick & easy! Here's the scoop...

Monday drive-thrus (& the first few days of camp) are longer wait times as first-time families learn the routine. Help shorten the wait by:

- Watch the Orientation Video & read this information so you know what to do & where to go.
- Call us with any questions during the week prior to your camp rather than asking in the drive-thru.
- Have child's backpack on their lap so they may exit quickly. Do not put their belongings in the trunk.
- Have children ready to exit the vehicle & to do so once directed by staff.
- Driver & other non-camper passengers remain in the vehicle at all times.
- Drive-thru is held at the following times:

- Enter at the North Beach gate. Lake Membership card is REQUIRED for gate entry.
- Vehicles with pets inside will NOT be permitted through the LMVA gates.
- The Gate opens AT 8am. If you arrive prior to 8am, wait in the line of cars at the closed gate.
- NEVER-NEVER-NEVER ENTER THROUGH THE EXIT AT THE GATE ENTRANCE!
- Follow the CampCo directional signs straight ahead & then down towards the Drive-thru.
- Watch for & obey all stop signs, one-ways, & other signage in the parking lot. This route is ONE-WAY.
- Line up at the "Please Wait Here for Sign-in/Out" sign. Stay in your vehicle.
- Stop vehicle at the following stations:
 - **Tie Dye Shirts:** CampCo Tie Dye Shirts (\$15, Cash/Venmo).
 - **Dashboard Card:** Get a dashboard card & quick camper health check.
 - **Sign-in:** Site Director will sign in for each child.
Campers must be dropped off by an authorized person aged 16 years or older.
Tell Site Director if picking at 3:50-4pm (*we ONLY bring those campers out)
 - **Campers Exit Vehicle:** Pull your vehicle to the curb next to the grassy area. Put vehicle in "Park."
 - **Staff assist Campers from Vehicle:**
Staff will open passenger-side car doors to allow children to exit the vehicle & direct them onto the grassy area beside the drive-thru.
- After dropping off at the drive-thru, continue forward, then up the hill towards the exit.
- Sign out will be held at the same location.
- To speed the sign-out process at the end of the day, place your family's dashboard card showing through the driver's side front windshield & be prepared to show photo ID (staff closing that day may not know/recognize you). Photo ID must match the name of the person authorized to sign out for the day.
- Vehicles in the drive-thru get priority sign-in. Families who walk, bike or boat over will be signed in at the grassy area adjacent to the drive-thru once the drive-thru line is complete.
- If you are dropping off or picking up during "off hours" & having difficulty finding us, call the CampCo office to ask for the current location of campers; (949) 643-9008. **DO NOT ask the LMVA office where we are at any given time; they do not know where we are!**
- Picking up at non-drive thru times? Please avoid walk-in sign-out from 3:30pm-3:50pm & 5:30pm-5:50pm as campers & staff are very busy getting belongings together & preparing to walk to the drive-thru on time.
- For safety & proper supervision of campers, we will not do sign-in/out during our walk to & from drive-thru.
- Do NOT drop your child off & have them walk over unescorted!

In order to keep our camp day running with minimal interruptions, we request that families use our drive-thru times & are discouraged from parking & walking in to camp to sign-in & out at off-times. If you must drop off or pick your child outside of the drive-thru times, parents will need to park & walk their child to camp. Please wait just outside the camp boundaries (coned area) for staff to sign your child in or out. Only campers & staff are permitted within camp boundaries.

Late Pick-up Fees:

- Campers not signed out by an authorized person by 6pm will result in a \$2 per child for every minute late.
- Time is determined by Site Director's watch/phone. Late fees are due at pick-up payable by cash or Venmo.
- Repeated late pick-ups may result in suspension or dismissal from the program.

Emergencies:

- During & immediately after an emergency (ex. fire, police, severe earthquake or other emergency at or near camp), do NOT call the CampCo Office or the Club. It is vital that CampCo & camp site phone lines remain open so that we can make calls back & forth to our camp staff to check on campers, to call parents & to call emergency services, if necessary.
- CampCo will only telephone parents of campers who are injured or in need of parent pick-up. If everyone & everything is fine, parents will not be telephoned.
- Depending on the situation, we may send texts or emails, &/or post updates in our Facebook/Instagram so we may update multiple families quickly after an emergency.

Lunch/Snacks, Water & Snack Bar:

- Campers must bring a healthy morning snack & may either bring or purchase lunch & afternoon snack.
- The Snack Bar Camp Meals include [REDACTED]. CampCo Lunch Menu choices:

- Lunch orders are placed at 9:30am. Campers arriving after our order has been placed must either bring their lunch or their parents must order snack bar lunch & deliver the lunch to the child at camp at noon.
- Pack a lot of food; they are much more active & will likely eat more than on an average school day.
- Siblings must have separate lunch bags/boxes for each child.
- We are a "nut-free" camp. Please do not send pb&j sandwiches, Nutella, candies, cookies with nuts, etc...
- Campers usually eat lunch at 12pm.
- Afternoon snack: bring from home &/or bring cash for purchase from Snack Bar [REDACTED]
We recommend not sending more than [REDACTED] per child for Afternoon Snack Bar.
- Please send separate money for each sibling as campers go to the Snack Bar with their small group.
- Put Lunch/Snack money in a kid-wallet or ziplock with their name on it. Show your child where it will be in a side pocket of their backpack & remind them it stays in their bag until lunch order/snack bar time.
- Each camper is responsible for their own money & any change given.
- Campers may not share their money with other campers.
- CampCo reserves the right to limit campers' consumption of certain items from the Snack Bar (no nut items & limited candy/sugar treats).
- Leaders will remind campers to drink water & refill their water bottles at multiple times throughout the day. Please discuss with your child the importance of drinking a lot of water & refilling during the camp day.

CampCo Tie Dye Tuesdays & Thursdays:

- Campers are encouraged to wear CampCo Tie Dye T-shirts at camp, especially on Tuesdays & Thursdays.
- CampCo Tie Dye T-shirts are available during morning drive-thru lines for \$15 each, cash or Venmo.

Boating:

- Each morning, campers ages 8+ sign up boating choices. (Campers ages 5-7 will use party boats).
- Campers can sign up to use: Kayaks (age 10+) Pedal Boats (ages 8+) Party Boats (age 5+)
- For kayaks & pedal boats, Counselors accompany campers in their boat or a nearby boat.
- For party boats, a Counselor drives the boat.
- Campers & staff wear life jackets & remain seated while boating.
- During boating times, the ratio of counselors to campers is 1:10 (1:9 for party boats).

Swim Time General Info:

- Campers swim daily, weather-permitting, beginning between 1pm-1:30pm & ending at 2:30pm.
- CampCo uses a reserved section of the beach/lake (near lifeguard station #3) during swim time.
- Beach/sand play is available for campers who prefer not to or are unable to swim for the day.
- Campers must remain within the designated CampCo lake/beach boundaries (coned area) during swim time.
- Supervision during swim time includes CampCo staff at a 1:10 ratio, each of whom is trained in basic water rescue & safety measures, CPR & First Aid. Lake Mission Viejo provides trained lifeguards. Additionally, we use a "buddy-system" when in the water to ensure safety.

Swim Test:

- Not everyone is required to take the Swim Test.
- **Who should take the Swim Test?** Campers who are strong swimmers & want to do “deep end runs” out to the boundary markers of the swim area (as a group & accompanied by a counselor).
- **Who doesn’t need to take the Swim Test?** Campers who are not strong swimmers or prefer to stay in the shallow end.
- Parents may request that their child remain in the shallow end & not take the swim test (must be done through our office at least 7 days in advance in order to print onto our rosters).
- Passing swim test = Blue Wristband = Permitted to do deep-end runs with counselor.
- Not taking/not passing Swim Test = Orange Wristband = Play in shallow (chest-deep) swim area. A good portion of our campers will be in the “orange wristband” group.
- During the majority of swim time, all campers (blue/orange wristbands) will play in the shallow area.
- Swim Test is offered each Monday (or whatever is child's first day for the week). Campers test weekly. We do not test on Fridays.
- The swim test is challenging. Campers who pass must have strong swimming abilities & tend to be older campers. Your child’s safety is our highest priority. Therefore, we ask that parents stand by our staff if their child does not pass the swim test & that they do not request an exception or for the child to be tested again that week. Campers are permitted to re-test each week of summer camp.
- On a case-by-case basis, CampCo may waive the requirement to re-test every week for stronger swimmers who easily pass the swim test. These campers will be given “Permanent Blue Wristband” status for summer.
- Campers may not wear/use floaties or use flotation devices from home as it encourages campers to swim in a depth that is beyond their abilities.

Fishing:

- Campers will not be fishing, this summer, as stocking is on hold due to golden algae.
- Should conditions improve & stocking is resumed, we may add catch & release fishing onto our activities.

Campers Enrolled in on-site LMVA Junior Lifeguards Program:

- CampCo can provide complimentary drop-off & pick-up of campers to on-site LMVA Junior Lifeguards.
- This service is available only on days when Junior Lifeguards meets & dismisses at North Beach.
- To partake in this service, **answer the Junior Lifeguard Program questions during online CampCo registration system or update the info no later than 7 business days prior to camp.**
- CampCo does not stay with campers & is not responsible for campers while they attend Junior Lifeguards.

North Beach Summer Day Camp 2026 Participant Transfer & Cancellation Policy:

This camp is available for 5-days within a calendar week (full-week) or individual days within each calendar week.

Our online registration program allows Customers to make changes 24/7 from home. See details, below:

Immediately upon completion of Camp Registration through May 1, 2026	Transfer, Credit or Refund, less \$2 per camp day change fee*
May 2, 2026 until 5pm on the Friday prior to the First Day of Camp Day/Week	Transfer, Credit or Refund, less \$5 per camp day change fee*
Friday prior to Camp Day/Week at 5:01pm until Day of Camp at 7am	Transfer or Credit on CampCo Account, less \$5 per camp day change fee*
After 7am on the day of camp	No Transfer, Credit or Refund after 7am on day of camp. This includes no shows, illness, partial-day attendance, cancellations not completed by 7am deadline & all other reasons.

*Additional details regarding North Beach Camp Participant Transfer & Cancellation Policy:

- Campers registered for five days in a week receive a significant discount per day. Partial-week cancellations or transfers will result in the adjusted fees to the \$85/day (or \$80.75/day for siblings) for the remaining days of that week.
- No refunds or credits for the remainder of the current camp day/week if child is suspended.
- There are minimum & maximum participants permitted in each activity; activities may be cancelled due to low registration & no more registrations will be accepted when maximum has been reached.
- A 100% refund of camp fee will be given for any activities cancelled by CampCo.
- The 4% Online Registration Service Fee is nonrefundable.
- **To make reservation changes or cancellations:**
 - 1) Log into your CampCo account through our website: www.CampcoDayCamps.com
 - 2) Go to My Reservations,
 - 3) Go to Current Reservations
 - 4) Click on the reservation week you would like to change/cancel
 - 5) To cancel or switch an individual day within that week (while keeping others), go to Options, Edit Options, then uncheck the day no longer needed. OR To cancel ALL of your registered days within that week, click "Cancel this Reservation."
 - 6) Follow online directions to make appropriate changes.

NOTE: If you want to "transfer" to another week, first cancel the days/reservation you don't want, THEN add the new reservation into your cart so you may use the credit as payment towards the items in your cart.
- After customer cancels online, any credit is automatically placed onto customer's CampCo account. CampCo credits are valid for future CampCo activities & are valid for at least one year from the date of the cancelled reservations. If customer prefers refund of any eligible credit on account, customer must request via email to our office.
